Allotments: so far 6 plots have been taken. No rent will be charged until October, only a small fee for water. Contact Mrs Sue Garnham on 828673, evenings please, if you are interested.

Green Waste: Green Waste is being dumped in the car park at the Village Hall. The Green Waste Lorry calls on Saturdays at the Village Hall car park between 12.15 pm and 12.45 pm. Residents are requested not to just leave the waste in the car park, but to empty it into the special lorry during these times. If you miss the lorry please take your waste home – do not leave it in car park or put it into the village hall waste bin.

Cold Norton Primary School: permission has been granted for the installation of a temporary single storey relocatable classroom unit with toilet facilities for a period of five years.

Potholes on the bridge: these will be repaired in April.

Village Hall Extension: Maldon District Council has granted planning permission for: a new meeting room, store and entrance, plus new children's toilets next to the main hall, also an extension to the existing committee room and for the car park to be adapted and enlarged. The Village Hall Project Team is preparing an application for submission to the Big Lottery Community Fund, from which it is hoped that the bulk of the monies required will come. The remainder will be sought from a variety of other potential fund providers, including the Parish Council, and monies being raised through activities initiated by the Village Hall Management Committee.
