**Highways News:** vegetation on the footways down to Country Produce should be trimmed back this month. Drain outside school has shown no improvement, even though the new pipe work in Latchingdon Road has been completed, so arrangements in hand for it to be jetted again, also scheduled to be jetted is the drain on the corner of The Fairways. Still awaiting results of camera survey re water on Latchingdon Road near Bardwell Yard/Coal yard.

**Community Allotments:** the PCT who have organised the regeneration of the allotments have now successfully arranged for water to be installed on the site, which will make a huge difference to this project. Thanks must go to the very kind resident who has assisted with installing the necessary pipe work.

**Path from Railway Bridge, back of/along Ferris Avenue & Station**

**Crescent:** this has been much used as a right of way for many years, but it is not shown as such on the definitive map. If it were officially recognised the County Council would maintain it. In order for this to happen we need to provide the CC with evidence of its use. So if you have at any time, used this route e.g. taking your children to/from school or going/coming back from a shopping trip to Country Produce, to avoid the main road, please contact the Parish Clerk – we need evidence from current and past users.
