**HOUSE/MAL/17/00706 Cranswick Lodge, Victoria Road:**

Single storey rear/side infill extension and alterations to rear patio and rear garden wall.  
Week No.28 dated 14th July 2017:

The Parish Council raised no objections and had no comments to make.

**FUL/MAL/17/00675 The Old Fire Station, Latchingdon Road:**

Construct 2 x new 5 bedroom detached houses with 4 x new parking places.  
Week No.29 dated 21st July 2017:

The Parish Council raised no objections, but the following comment was included:

*The Parish Council has no objection to this application, but feels that for properties of this size there is an under provision of car parking spaces and that 3-4 spaces per property should be provided as there is no parking on Latchingdon Road.*
